- A.** Enumerated. When there is an accumulation of two (2) inches or more of snow or an expected accumulation of one-eighth ($1/8$) inch or more of ice due to freezing rain on the basis of a forecast by the National Weather Service, there shall be no parking on the following list of streets:

Camden Street

Crispin Street

Garner Street

Grandview Street

Hill Street

Institute Street

Lexington Street

North Main Street

Royle Street

South Street

Thornton Street

Wellington Street (from Pine to South Street)

Whitmer Street (from S. Camden to Main Street)

Wilson Avenue

Wollard Boulevard

- B.** Authority Of Police To Move — Fine. In the event any vehicles are parked on the streets, alongside the streets, on the hard surface of the street or on the shoulders of the street, or any portion of the vehicle extends upon the traveled area of said street, the officers of the Police Department shall have the authority to have said vehicles moved by towing or other provisions. Additionally, there may be a fine imposed from a minimum of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) to one hundred dollars (\$100.00), along with the expense of towing or removing said motor vehicle.
