DESCRIPTION:

The City of Richmond is accepting applications for a Patrol Officer position in the Richmond Police Department. We are currently seeking professional and community oriented individuals interested in law enforcement.

Qualifications:

Qualified applicants shall possess a high school diploma, college level is preferred. Minimum 21 years of age. Applicants must also be Missouri P.O.S.T. certified, have a good driving record, possess good communication skills, and be of good moral character.

Salary:

Starting salary based on qualifications, plus benefits. Benefits package includes paid holidays, vacation and sick leave, Missouri Local Government Employees Retirement System (LAGERS), medical, dental, vision and life insurance. Available voluntary benefits include Aflac supplemental insurance, 457(b) retirement plan, term life insurance, health savings account (HSA) and flexible spending accounts (FSA) for medical expenses and dependent care.

Must submit City of Richmond "Application for Employment" for consideration.
