DESCRIPTION:

The City of Richmond is accepting applications for Southview Pool Lifeguards. This position is responsible for ensuring the safety of patrons by preventing and responding to emergencies and assist in maintaining the pool and surrounding area to desired standards.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

A lifeguard employed with the City of Richmond Recreation Department is responsible for the health, safety and welfare of those using the Southview Pool. A Lifeguard's major responsibility is to observe swimmers and enforce regulations in the guarding of life and the prevention of accidents at the Southview Pool. Lifeguards will also teach swim lessons.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Successful applicant must have strong swimming skills (must be able to swim 300 yards, swim to bottom of pool in the deep end, tread water for at least two minutes, etc), strong observational skills, strong communication skills, an excellent level of concentration, and the ability to keep calm and act quickly in an emergency. Applicants must be at least 15 years old and have a current American Red Cross Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR/AED Certification, or be able to obtain certification by May 25, 2019. Applicants must be available to work evenings, weekends, and some holidays.

SALARY:

Base salary: \$8.60 per hour.

Must submit City of Richmond "Application for Employment". Applications may be rejected if incomplete.
