

CITY COMPOST/BRUSH SITE FAQ's

Who can use the City Compost Site?

Residents of the City of Richmond can use the Compost Site.

When is the Compost Site open?

The Compost Site is open Monday through Saturday from 7:00 am to 4:00 pm between the months of April and November.

What materials are acceptable?

Brush/tree limbs/sticks (no more than 6 inches in diameter and 4 feet long) , yard and garden vegetation, grass clippings, plant residues, straw, hay, leaves, compostable bags are acceptable.

What materials are NOT acceptable

Plastic bags, plastic, lumber, metal, tires, trash, soil, paper, man-made materials, animals/animal carcasses/animal waste are not acceptable.

Where do I place items I am dropping off?

Place all materials in the designated concrete pad area at the site. Do NOT place items in dumpster.

Can commercial customers use this service?

The Compost Site is for residential customers only. No commercial users are allowed to dump at the site.

Is there a fee for dumping or do I need a compost card?

There is no additional fee for use of the Compost Site. Residential users will not be issued a compost card, but may be asked for proof of residency.

Is activity at the site monitored?

The Compost Site is under video surveillance 24 hours a day 7 days a week.

Are there any other options for getting rid of yard waste?

Yes! The City offers weekly curbside yard waste pick-up for all residential customers. Simply place bundled limbs or biodegradable bags at the curb each week.
