

WEEKLY CURBSIDE YARD WASTE PICK-UP FAQ's

When will my yard waste be picked up?

Pick-up will be Mondays for those West of 13 Hwy and Wednesdays for those East of 13 Hwy.

What yard waste materials are acceptable?

Yard waste including leaves, grass clippings, vegetation in biodegradable bags and brush/tree limbs (bundled) are acceptable materials.

Is there a limit for the amount of materials picked-up each week?

10 biodegradable bags (no plastic) of yard waste or no more than three (3) 20-gallon containers that can be lifted and dumped into the truck or sticks and limbs cut and tied into bundles no larger than two (2) feet in diameter and no longer than four (4) feet in length.

Where do I place items for pick-up?

Place all materials at curb.

Are plastic trash bags acceptable?

Plastic bags containing yard waste will NOT be collected.

Can commercial customers use this service?

Weekly yard waste pick-up is for residential customers only.

Will my trash rate increase?

The City has kept rates the same since 2012. There will be an increase of \$1.50 per month for all residential trash customers which will begin during the April 2020 billing cycle.

Can I still take yard waste items to the Compost Site?

The Compost Site is open Monday -Saturday 7:00 am to 4:00 pm for Richmond residents. Place yard waste materials on the concrete pad, not in the dumpster.
