The City of Richmond is accepting applications for a Wastewater Plant Operator. This position is responsible for the day to day operations of the Wastewater Plant. Must be able to perform and understand all lab tests that are required for plant operations, mechanical ability to make minor adjustments and repairs to operating equipment.

Successful applicant must have graduated high school or trade school or equivalent, valid Missouri drivers' license, and proficient in basic computer skills. Special consideration will be given to candidates who have completed a training program in wastewater treatment plants with an emphasis on Sequencing Batch Reactors (SBR's), as well as those candidates who possess a Class A or B Wastewater Treatment certification issued by Missouri DNR.
